The 80's began exhibiting in New York City: Poindexter Gallery, Victoria Munroe Fine Art.

1980 – 2021, a time of numerous travels to Europe and Japan including 14 journeys to India.

During mid-1980's first time my paintings were exhibited at the MFA in Boston and London, UK.

Around my numerous travels to India I focused the studio work on my deep interest in **Indian Miniature** painting. I borrowed a wide range of imagery from many Indian and Mughal sources: paintings of gardens, animals, textiles, sculpture, temple architecture. Alongside this imagery, I fused a gathering of New England marsh and coastal landscape scenes.

In time, this body of art work led to **MFABoston** curators inviting me to create a series of works on paper referencing 15th -16c miniature paintings portraying animals in the MFA Collections. The MFA exhibition **"Glorious Beasts"** was reviewed in an article in the Globe's Sunday Magazine.

Mid 1990's I started collecting Textiles from India and Japan. And also began collection 19c photographs shot in India.

In 2001, with my late partner, I began gradually acquiring 17c -19c drawings originally used as studies for Indian miniatures paintings.

In 2014 our Collection of 68 Indian drawings was acquired by the Philadelphia Museum of Art .

In 2016 the 68 Indian drawings were exhibited as a large solo museum exhibition **"Drawn From Courtly India"** and catalogue written by Curator Darielle Mason and Asst. Curator Ainsley Cameron.

2007-2014 I presented and exhibited the art works of over 70 underserved artists working in Greater Boston through a series of well attended one week thematic **POP-UP@1140** exhibitions in my South End studio.
